## The Annual 47th Congressional District High School Art Competition

An Artistic Discovery is open to high school students (grades 9-12) who reside in the 47th Congressional District of California. To check your congressional district, please visit [www.house.gov](http://www.house.gov). Students are only allowed one entry per year.

The entry must be an original concept and design and may **not** violate any U.S. copyright laws. The entry must **not** reproduce an existing photo, painting, graphic advertisement or any other work produced by another person. The work may not infringe on the rights of any third party. Mounting your entry to a mat board is strongly recommended.

### **GUIDELINES**

Artwork must be two dimensional and no larger than 28 inches high by 28 inches wide by 4 inches deep (28" X 28" X 4") and cannot weigh more than 15 lbs.

Accepted mediums for artwork are as follows:

- ❖ Paintings- Oil, acrylics, watercolor, etc.
- ❖ Drawings- pastels, colored pencil, pencil, charcoal, ink, markers
- ❖ Collage
- ❖ Prints- lithographs, silkscreen, block prints
- ❖ Mixed Media- use of more than two medias such as pencil, ink, watercolor, etc.
- ❖ Computer-Generated Art
- ❖ Photography

### **DEADLINE FOR ALL ENTRIES**

All entries must be submitted in April to the district office of Congressman Alan Lowenthal located at 100 West Broadway, West Tower, Suite 600 | Long Beach, CA 90802.

Each student must submit her/his art mounted on white or black mounting board. An Entry/Release Forms must be completed and attached to the back. Please note that the 47th Congressional District Art Competition Committee reserves the right to refuse art work that does not comply with art competition rules and guidelines.
